



Recyclable Materials

All owners and occupants of single family and 2 to 4 unit residences, multiple-family dwelling and non-residential facilities and properties shall separate the following recyclable materials from post consumer waste. All recyclable materials should be prepared in the following manner.



Plastic, glass, aluminum and tin can all be placed together in a 13 gallon or larger clear garbage bag.

ALUMINUM – Clean

TIN CANS – Rinse and remove labels

GLASS – Rinse, remove labels, caps, covers and rings.



PLASTIC – With numbers of #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #7 also wax covered milk & juice containers

Rinse and remove labels and caps.



CARDBOARD – All clean corrugated cardboard shall be flattened, kept dry and bundled or placed in a box



Newspaper, High Grade Paper and Low Grade Paper may be bundled or placed in a brown paper bag and kept dry. They can not be combined together in one bag.

NEWSPAPER – Newspapers including inserts



HIGH GRADE PAPER – Computer/Copy paper, junk mail and envelopes

LOW GRADE PAPER – Magazines, cake, cereal, pop, gift boxes, catalogs, egg cartons and gift wrap
